This conference is aimed at medical and nursing professionals who investigate and manage thyroid nodules and cancer, including oncologists, endocrinologists, ENT and endocrine surgeons, radiologists, pathologists and specialist nurses. Trainees from all specialities are welcome.

Content

The topics of the talks have been chosen to highlight areas of uncertainty in thyroid nodule and cancer practice in the UK, and will be delivered by experts in the field. Topics will cover the path from diagnosis to treatment; including a review of pros and cons of various radiological classification systems for thyroid nodules, molecular testing of thyroid nodules, stratification of pathological risk, surgical management of low risk DTC and surveillance strategy of papillary microcarcinoma.

A key objective for the meeting is to identify topics for the design of nationwide, collaborative research studies to address the unmet needs that have been highlighted from the meeting. These will be discussed at a half day workshop on Saturday – all who might be interested in contributing to such studies are welcome to attend the workshop. CPD points have been applied for.
